



Zespri Horticultural Scholarship

Zespri is providing up to \$10,000 towards tuition fees for two outstanding current university students to support their studies towards a career in the horticulture industry. This could include degrees in science, management, marketing, nutrition or business for example. The scholarship also includes opportunities to be involved with the kiwifruit industry.

To be eligible for a Zespri Horticultural Scholarship you need to:

- Have passed NCEA Level 3 with merit or excellence.
- Pass (or be on track to pass) your first year of tertiary studies with a B+ average or higher.
- Be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident.
- Give examples of how your study will benefit the horticulture industry.
- Provide examples of your leadership skills, community service and/or sporting or cultural activities.

Applications open on Monday 14 August 2023 and close on Friday 6 October 2023 at 5pm.

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8. The Selection Process

Applications are reviewed by Zespri's External Relations team. A short list of applicants will be drawn up after the initial review process is completed.

Applications are then discussed by the Scholarship Selection Panel. If candidates are required for a face-to-face interview, Zespri will fund the cost of travel.

Successful applicants will be contacted by phone and officially notified by email. Unsuccessful applicants will be notified by email. All applicants will know the outcome of their applications no later than Friday 3 November 2023.

By signing this application form, applicants selected for a scholarship give permission to Zespri International Ltd (Zespri) to:

10. Terms and Conditions

The Zespri Scholarships are awarded to outstanding students with a particular interest in horticulture who are pursuing their second year of tertiary study.

A maximum of two scholarships will be awarded each year for two years to the total value of \$10,000 each (\$5,000 per person per year).

Applicants must:

- Achieve an academic grade average of B+ or higher in the previous year of their course.
- Be a New Zealand Citizen or a New Zealand Permanent Resident.
- Have registered in full-time tertiary study at a New Zealand university (or such other course approved in advance by Zespri) by 31 March in the year of the award.

- Provide examples of how tertiary study will support the development of the New Zealand horticulture industry.
- Demonstrate potential leadership skills, service to the community and/or sporting activities.
- Be willing to contribute to the promotion of the New Zealand horticulture industry (such as school visits, career days etc), if successful.

Additional terms:

1. Scholars must achieve an academic grade average of B+ or higher in the previous year of their course for continued eligibility, the maintenance of such grade average being at Zespri's discretion.
2. Stipends of \$5,000 payments will be made annually to students meeting these terms and conditions and paid out at the end of each successful academic year on proof of B+ grades (at minimum) being achieved. The first payment will be made at the end of 2024.
3. Each scholarship is tenable up to two years only.
4. The scholarship can be awarded with any other scholarship or bursary provided the rules of the other allow it.
5. The scholarship will be awarded on the recommendation of the Zespri Scholarships Selection Committee.
6. Scholarship recipients agree that Zespri International Limited will be able to publicise the student's name, photograph and biographical details in company promotional material and the news media.
7. Zespri International Limited does not make any express or implied offer of employment to any scholarship recipient.
8. Zespri International Limited reserves the right to revoke any scholarship if the scholar should, in the opinion of Zespri, bring Zespri and/or the kiwifruit industry into disrepute.
